WHEREAS, March 2017 is recognized as Behavioral Disability Awareness Month. Nationally, there are more than five million Americans who have a developmental disability, and

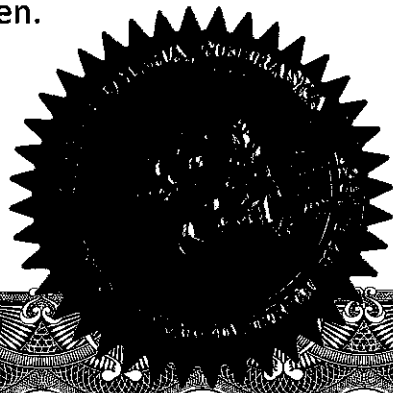
